RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE ASSEMBLY'S POLICY ON EXCUSED
AND UNEXCUSED ABSENCES FROM REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE ASSEMBLY.

WHEREAS, Section 3.7 of the Charter and the city and borough code provisions governing the Assembly provide that if an assemblymember fails to attend three consecutive regular meetings of the Assembly without being excused by the Assembly, that the Assembly shall take certain action regarding a resolution of forfeiture of office, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly does not currently have a policy on what constitutes an excused or an unexcused absence from an Assembly meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has determined that a policy on excused and unexcused absences should be established;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That any absence of an assemblymember from a regular meeting of the Assembly shall be deemed to be unexcused unless the assemblymember is absent from the meeting as a result of attending to official business on behalf of the City and Borough of Juneau, or for extenuating medical reasons, in which case the absence shall be deemed to be excused.

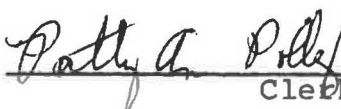
2. The city clerk shall provide to the Assembly on a quarterly basis a report on attendance at regular Assembly meetings.

3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
