RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE APPOINTEE-DESIGNATE TO THE POSITION OF CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Assembly, by Resolution No. 1510 has adopted Personnel Rules which provide for the appointment of municipal employees, including the Chief of Police, and

WHEREAS, Personnel Rule 10 PR 150, provides that no salary, wage or benefit may be paid to an employee except as provided in the Personnel Rules or as required by state or federal law, and

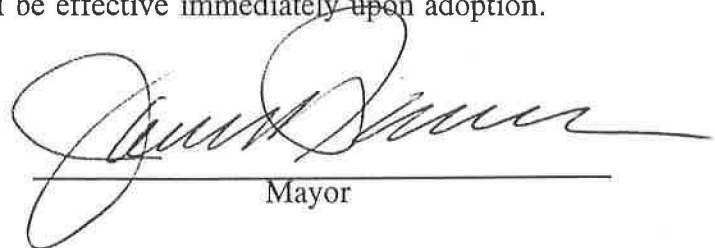
WHEREAS, in order to secure the most qualified appointee for the position of Chief of Police, it is necessary to offer benefits other than as provided in the Personnel Rules;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. Notwithstanding Resolution No. 1510 and the Personnel Rules adopted thereunder, the Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement for appointment to and employment in the position of Chief of Police for the vacancy existing at the time of the adoption of this resolution, which agreement may contain benefits other than those provided by the Personnel Rules.

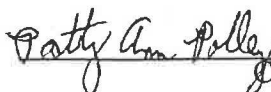
2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
