A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE LABOR AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU AND THE MARINE ENGINEERS BENEFICIAL ASSOCIATION, AFL-CIO.

WHEREAS, the negotiating team representing the City and Borough of Juneau has reached an agreement with the negotiating team representing the employees in the City and Borough of Juneau general government bargaining unit, and

WHEREAS, the union has reported that its membership has ratified the tentative agreement, and

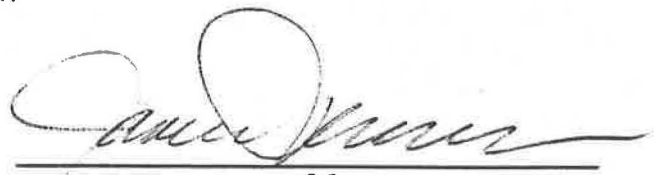
WHEREAS, CBJ 44.10.120 requires that the Assembly ratify such agreements by resolution before they become effective;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the tentative labor agreement between the City and Borough of Juneau and the Marine Engineers Beneficial Association, AFL-CIO, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is approved and ratified by the Assembly.

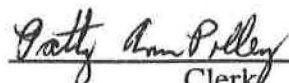
2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

Proposed Manager's Report

Resolution 1722:

Since March 3, 1994, the CBJ bargaining team has been meeting with the Marine Engineers Beneficial Association bargaining team to reach agreement on a labor contract for covered employees of the Administration, Airport, Community Development, Engineering, Finance, Fire, Health and Social Services, Parks and Recreation and Public Works departments. The Assembly has been apprised on the status of these negotiations from time to time throughout the process. The tentative agreement complies with the Assembly's guidelines.

CBJ 44.10.120 requires ratification by the Assembly before the tentative agreement can be signed or implemented.

The union was scheduled to tabulate its membership ratification vote on August 26. I will advise the assembly as soon as possible of the outcome of the vote.
