RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A Resolution Authorizing the Manager to Apply for and Receive a Recovery Act, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant, From the U.S. Department of Justice, for Purchasing Police Equipment to Assist in Drug Enforcement Activities.

WHEREAS, under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act), the U.S. Department of Justice was provided funding for grants to assist state, local, and tribal law enforcement, to combat illegal drug crimes; and

WHEREAS, the grants are to be provided by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance, under "The Recovery Act Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Formula Program"; and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau has been allocated \$35,894 under this Recovery Act grant program and wishes to apply for these grant funds; and

WHEREAS, there are no City and Borough matching requirements for this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. That the Manager is authorized to apply for and receive from the U.S. Department of Justice a Recovery Act, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant, for the purpose of funding the purchase of police equipment to aid police officers with drug enforcement activities.

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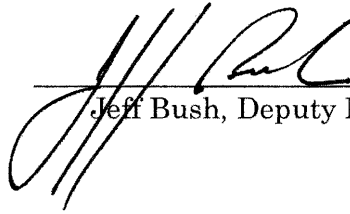
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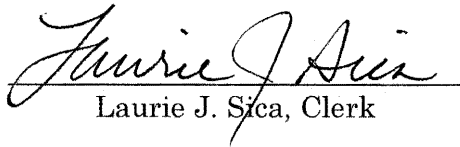
Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
