A RESOLUTION HONORING TOM AND KOGGIE FILE FOR THE CREATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MENDENHALL GOLF COURSE.

WHEREAS, although a golf course in the valley has been the subject of many complex plans and lengthy studies, all such efforts have failed to combine this great sport and this beautiful location into a real recreational opportunity for Juneau, and

WHEREAS, Tom and Koggie File using their own time, land, and finances, have succeeded where all others failed and have created the Mendenhall Golf Course, and

WHEREAS, said Mendenhall Golf Course provides a uniquely Alaskan golfing experience, complete with bald eagles, a glacier view, wildflowers, tall grass, and "rough" worthy of St. Andrew's in Scotland;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:
