RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1697

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE 1994 SCHEDULE OF FEES AND RATES FOR THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU PORT FACILITIES, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 1561.

WHEREAS, CBJ 85.30.040 provides that the Harbor Board shall annually, or more often as the need may arise, review and approve a schedule of fees and rates for the use of the city and borough port facilities, and

WHEREAS, Resolution Serial No. 1561, adopted on April 6, 1992, established the current schedule of fees and rates for the city and borough port facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Harbor Board has reviewed the current schedule and recommends the adoption of the fees and rates set forth herein, and

WHEREAS, CBJ 85.30.040 further provides that the schedule approved by the Harbor Board shall be forwarded to the Assembly for review and adoption by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

* Section 1. City and Borough Port Facility Fees and Rates. The schedule of fees and rates for the city and borough port facilities shall be as follows:

A. Dockage Fee. Every vessel utilizing the dock or ferry terminal facilities shall be assessed and pay a dockage fee for each port visit. The dockage fee shall be calculated

based on the following rates:

<u>Vessel Length</u> <u>Overall (LOA)</u>	<u>Rate Per Foot</u>
Over 700 feet	\$ 2.22
600 - 700 feet	\$ 1.80
500 - 599 feet	\$ 1.44
400 - 499 feet	\$ 1.14
300 - 399 feet	\$ 0.90
200 - 299 feet	\$ 0.72
Under 200 feet	\$ 0.60

B. Lightering Fee. Every vessel utilizing the lightering areas shall be assessed and pay a lightering fee of \$340.00 for each twenty-four hour period that the vessel utilizes such areas.

C. Transfer Bridge Fee. Every vessel utilizing the transfer bridge shall be assessed and pay a transfer bridge fee of \$36.00 per hour.

D. Potable Water Fee. Every vessel receiving potable water from a city and borough dockside water connection shall be assessed and pay a potable water fee of \$1.75 per thousand gallons.

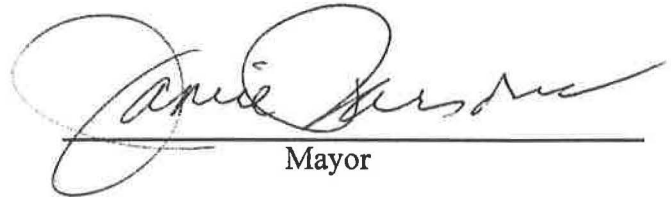
E. Port Dues. Vessels carrying passengers for compensation and utilizing the port facilities and not specifically exempted under CBJ 85.30.050(e) shall be assessed and pay port dues of \$0.16 per net registered ton for each port visit, the establishment of such dues by resolution being authorized as provided in CBJ 85.30.050(d).

F. Intermediate Vessel Float Moorage Fee. Every vessel utilizing the intermediate vessel float shall be assessed and pay a moorage fee of \$0.35 per linear foot of vessel length overall (LOA) per twenty-four hour period, or portion thereof, except that reduced "off season" rates, based upon applicable small boat harbor moorage rates, shall apply from October 1 through March 31 of each year.

* Section 2. Repeal of Resolution. Resolution No. 1561 is hereby repealed.

* Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
