RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT
COMMITTEE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Americans With Disabilities Act is to further the goal of full participation of people with disabilities in our society by giving civil rights protection to individuals with disabilities, and

WHEREAS, the Act guarantees equal opportunity for people with disabilities in employment, public accommodations, transportation, state and local government services, and telecommunications, and

WHEREAS, the city and borough desires to promote and support the goals of the Act, and incorporate participation by the general public and by people with disabilities, and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of these goals the Assembly in 1992 established pursuant to Resolution 1585 the Americans with Disabilities Act Committee of the City and Borough of Juneau, and

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Resolution 1585 provided that the Committee would be abolished effective July 1, 1995, unless extended by the Assembly by resolution and that no later than June 1, 1995, the Committee should submit a written report to the clerk making a recommendation to the Assembly on whether the Committee should continue to exist, and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 1995, the Committee delivered to the clerk for consideration by the Assembly Committee on Committees a report of its activities, which report establishes that while much has been done to achieve the goals of the Committee, much remains to be done, and recommended that the Committee be extended, and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Committees at its meeting of June 5, 1995, concurred in the recommendation for extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

* Section 1. Committee Extended. The City and Borough of Juneau Americans With Disabilities Committee is extended until July 1, 1998, whereupon it shall be abolished unless further extended by the Assembly by resolution. By no later than June 1, 1998, the Committee shall submit a written report to the clerk making a recommendation to the Assembly on whether the Committee should continue to exist.

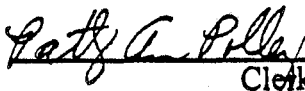
* Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
