RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1832

A Resolution Accepting and Implementing the Recommendations of the Mayor's Task Force on Acquisition and Construction of a New Police Station and Commending the Members for Their Efforts on Behalf of the Community.

WHEREAS, quality police services are essential to the public welfare, and

WHEREAS, the leased facility currently occupied by the Juneau Police Department is overcrowded, antiquated, and entirely inadequate to support the delivery of quality police services to the people of Juneau, and

WHEREAS, construction of a new facility is the most efficient and effective method of addressing this need, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed a task force of citizens known as the Mayor's Task Force on Acquisition and Construction of a New Police Station to recommend the best course of action, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly and the Task Force share the goal of informing the public about the costs and benefits of the police station project, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has accepted the Task Force recommendation that the project be funded through a sales tax, and has by Ordinance 96-33 proposed to the voters at the October 1 regular municipal election a temporary 1% sales tax for 21 months to fund acquisition and construction of a police station, and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate at this time to confirm the municipal policies that will guide and limit the police station project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. That the Assembly adopts as its policy the Task Force recommendation that the facility be located on one of three sites proposed by the Task Force.

Section 2. That the Assembly further adopts as its policy the recommendation that the facility be designed to accommodate police department needs with a base building size of approximately 27,400 sq. ft.

Section 3. That the Manager is directed to develop the project budget in a manner that will disclose all costs associated with the project, including inflation, site improvements, project management, inspection, and construction, which shall total approximately \$9 million.

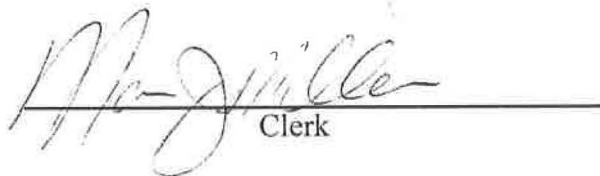
Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
