RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE 1991 SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU SMALL BOAT HARBORS AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 1393.

WHEREAS, CBJ 85.02.100 provides that the Harbor Board of Directors shall annually, or more often as the need may arise, review and approve the schedule of fees and charges for the use of the city and borough harbors and related facilities, and

WHEREAS, Resolution Serial No. 1393 established the current schedule of fees and charges for the City and Borough of Juneau small boat harbors, and

WHEREAS, the Harbor Board has reviewed the current schedule of fees and charges and recommends that the schedule be revised as set forth herein, and

WHEREAS, CBJ 85.02.100 further provides that the fee schedule approved by the Harbor Board must be transmitted to the Assembly for adoption by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

* Section 1. Amendment of Fee Schedule. The CBJ Harbor Department Fee Schedule is amended to read:

A. Amounts and Rates Established Annually. The harbor board will recommend fee amounts and rates annually. Copies of the fee schedule will be available at the harbor office.

B. Preferential Assigned Moorage Waitlist Fees.

C. Preferential Assigned Moorage Annual Rate.

Base Rate + Linear Rate

1. Base Rate

Full Access Slips \$370.00 per slip

Limited Access
Slips \$250.00 per slip

Where the Base Rate is determined by dividing the primary harbor operating costs by the number of assignable slips (except that limited access slips shall be a lesser annual rate).

0 - 19'	\$.88
20'	1.32
21 - 29'	1.75
30'	2.63
31 - 39'	3.50
40'	5.25
41 - 49'	7.00
50'	10.50
51 - 69'	14.00

Where the Linear Rate is a graduated per foot charge based upon vessel length over all (LOA) to fund replacement reserves, minor capital projects, and special costs related to vessel size.

N. Wharfage Fee.

1. Wharfage Fee \$ 2.50 per ton

Wharfage fee to be assessed on any freight passing over, through, or under, any CBJ harbor dock, except ship's stores or equipment and gear intended for the harvest of seafood.

* Section 2. Repeal of Resolution. Resolution No. 1393 is hereby repealed.

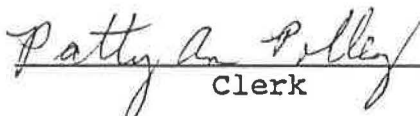
* Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
