RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION URGING THE ALASKA CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO ENSURE THAT ANY CONGRESSIONAL ACTION AFFECTING THE TONGASS NATIONAL FOREST INCLUDE PROVISION AND APPROPRIATION FOR A SOUTHEAST ECONOMIC DIVERSIFICATION FUND.

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau enjoys and appreciates its close relationship with its neighbors in Southeast Alaska, and

WHEREAS, many Southeast communities will be affected by the diminished timber activity in Southeast due to decreased availability of timber on private lands, and

WHEREAS, Tongass legislation may have further effects on the timber industry and Southeast communities, and

WHEREAS, the well-being of Southeast Alaska is of the utmost importance to and is the responsibility of each and every community;

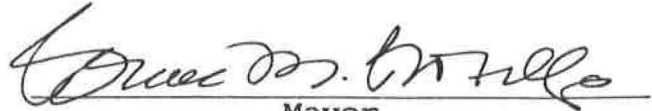
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau strongly and respectfully urges Alaska's Congressional delegation to ensure that any congressional action affecting the Tongass National Forest include provision and appropriation for a Southeast economic diversification fund.

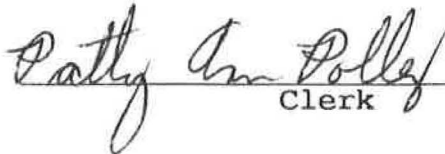
