

### CHALLENGES AND ISSUES outdated regulations

Commercial use regulations were **last updated in 2004** and do not address emerging trends or newly appointed CBJ parks and trails. **Unmanaged permits** midway through 2023 placed **unexpected pressures** on CBJ managed park lands and trails.
