The court is in receipt of the parties' joint response<sup>1</sup> to its order of August 22, 2016,<sup>2</sup> with respect to scheduling oral argument on defendants' motion to dismiss for lack of jurisdiction.<sup>3</sup> Unfortunately, the parties were unable to reach an agreement as to either the type or the location of oral argument.

This case was filed at Juneau, Alaska, and involves the City and Borough of Juneau. The case involves a subject likely to be of some local interest. Plaintiffs' counsel reside in Anchorage, Alaska, and Washington, D.C. Defense counsel resides in Juneau, Alaska.

In consideration of the foregoing, oral argument on defendants' motion to dismiss is now scheduled for Tuesday, September 27, 2016, at 10:30 a.m., at the Federal Building & U.S. Courthouse, 709 West 9th Street, Juneau, Alaska. Non-resident counsel may

participate by telephone if arrangements to do so are made with the court's case manager<sup>4</sup> well in advance of the date scheduled for oral argument. Oral argument will be limited to 20 minutes per side.

In the event that inclement weather prevents counsel or the court from traveling to Juneau, oral argument will be rescheduled at the earliest possible date after September 27; but in that event, oral argument will be scheduled for the U.S. Courthouse & Federal Building, 222 West 7th Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska.
