ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2018-32

**An Ordinance Amending Title 72 of the City and Borough of Juneau Code
Relating to Driving Without a License.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the City and Borough of Juneau Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Subsection. CBJ 72.10.065 Drivers must be licensed, is amended at subsection (d), to read:

72.10.065 Drivers must be licensed.

- (a) A person may not be denied the privilege to drive a motor vehicle upon a highway in this municipality, except as prescribed by law.
- (b) Every person exercising the person's privilege to drive, or exercising any degree of physical control of a motor vehicle upon a highway, vehicular way or area, or other public property in this municipality, is required to have in the possession of the person a valid state driver's license issued under the provisions of this chapter for the type or class of vehicle driven, unless expressly exempted by law from this requirement.
- (c) A person licensed under the provisions of this chapter may exercise in this municipality the privilege to drive a motor vehicle and is subject to the restrictions prescribed by this chapter.
- (d) A person convicted for a violation of this section is guilty of an infraction punishable by a fine of not more than \$300.00, except that if the person's license has been expired less than one year, a conviction under this section is punishable by a fine of \$75.00. In addition to any fine, the privilege to drive may be lost as a result of the accumulation of points under AS 28.15.221—AS 28.15.261.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its adoption.
