During the week of May 14th, Docks & Harbors celebrated the 2018 Infrastructure Week (iWeek) with a series of presentations and ribbon cutting ceremonies each day of the week culminating with recognition of the completion of the Aurora Harbor Phase II project and a Customer Appreciation cook-out. I especially want to recognize Mayor Koelsch who attended and vigorously participated each of the daily events. The Mayor also signed an iWeek Proclamation. Infrastructure Week is an annual event which educates and advocates for improvements in our infrastructure. The national iWeek steering group includes AFL-CIO, Chamber of Commerce and the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE). As the President of ASCE (Alaska Section), it has been my honor to work with talented, volunteer ASCE members throughout the state in advancing the civil engineering profession. Last year, the Alaska Section released the inaugural State Report Card on Infrastructure. This year my colleagues and I released a video update to our efforts from the previous year.
