RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1964

A Resolution in Support of Efforts by the Alaska Lighthouse Association to Restore the Point Retreat Lighthouse Station.

WHEREAS, the lighthouses of Alaska played a vital role in the early history and development of the state, and continue to serve as important aids to navigation and reminders of our maritime heritage, and

WHEREAS, the Point Retreat Lighthouse Station is a familiar landmark to Juneau residents and visitors, is qualified for inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places, is on a Scenic By-way of the Alaska Marine Highway System, and provides significant educational, recreational, and tourism opportunities, and


WHEREAS, the Alaska Lighthouse Association, a non-profit corporation headquartered in Juneau, has undertaken to rehabilitate and restore the Point Retreat Lighthouse Station, to develop a maritime heritage museum and natural history interpretive center at the site, and to make these new recreational and educational opportunities accessible to the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. Project Endorsement. The City and Borough of Juneau endorses efforts by the Alaska Lighthouse Association to restore and rehabilitate Point Retreat Lighthouse Station and to increase public access to the site for the enjoyment and education of Juneau residents and visitors.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
