RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2008

A Resolution Authorizing the Manager to Submit to the State of Alaska an Application for a Federal Grant to Develop a Historic Preservation Website as part of the Capital City Home Page.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the CBJ comprehensive plan to educate, encourage and assist the general public in recognizing the value of historic preservation, and

WHEREAS, it is a goal of the Juneau library system to increase access the capital city via telecommunications, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the National Park Service Historic Preservation Act of 1966, certain federal matching grants for historic preservation projects are available to certified local governments, and

WHEREAS, the Juneau Historic Resources Advisory Committee has recommended application for a federal matching grant to develop a historic preservation website , and

WHEREAS, the draft Juneau historic preservation plan recommends that a historic preservation website be developed, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has reviewed the application prepared by the Community Development Department to develop a historic preservation website, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly is aware of the obligations and responsibilities that will be incurred by the City and Borough upon acceptance of the grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. That the Assembly hereby authorizes the manager to submit an application to the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Office of History and Archaeology, for a federal matching grant to complete development of a historic preservation website.

Section 2. That the Community Development Department is established as the agent for the City and Borough for administration of this project.

Section 3. That if the City and Borough is awarded the grant to complete development of a historic preservation website, the Assembly will introduce an ordinance providing matching funds for this project.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
