RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2082

A Resolution Authorizing the Manager to Convey an Easement Over Municipal Property at the Corner of Hurlock Avenue and Mendenhall Loop Road to the State of Alaska for Highway Maintenance Purposes.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities provides essential public services in the design, construction, and maintenance of roads and highways, and

WHEREAS, the Department has requested an easement from the City for a fraction of U. S. Survey 381, located at the corner of Hurlock Avenue and Mendenhall Loop Road, encompassing approximately 54 square feet, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the easement is to accommodate construction, reconstruction and maintenance of highway slopes, drainage facility and incidental purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed and approved the highway reconstruction project at its meeting November 9, 1999, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly Lands Committee reviewed and approved the easement at its meeting of March 5, 2001;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. The Manager is authorized to convey a perpetual easement, located within a fraction of U.S. Survey 381, and encompassing approximately 54 square feet to the State of Alaska, as depicted in Exhibit A.

Section 2. The purpose of the easement shall be for the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of highway slopes, drainage facility and incidental purposes.

Section 3. The sale price of the easement shall be \$200.00.


Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
