A Resolution De-Appropriating \$400,000 from the Dimond Park Aquatic Center Capital Improvement Project.

WHEREAS, under Article IX of the Home Rule Charter of the City and Borough of Juneau, the Assembly by resolution may reduce any appropriation, except for debt service or for cash deficit, provided that no appropriation may be reduced by more than the amount of the unencumbered balance; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2008-15(AY), adopted on March 16, 2009, appropriated \$400,000 in Temporary 1% Sales Tax to the Dimond Park Aquatic Center Capital Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2008-15(BC) appropriates a \$1,450,000 grant from the State of Alaska, Alaska Energy Authority, to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the contractors' bids submitted for the Project were lower than had been anticipated; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the grant and the fact that the contract awarded for the Project is in an amount lower than anticipated, the Project no longer requires the \$400,000 in sales tax funds.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska:

Section 1. The amount of \$400,000 in Temporary 1% Sales Tax is de-appropriated from the appropriation for the Dimond Park Aquatic Center Capital Improvement Project.
