RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2501

A Resolution Authorizing the Manager to Submit to the State of Alaska an Application for a Federal Grant for Phase II of the City and Borough of Juneau Historic Preservation Database.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the National Park Service Historic Preservation Act of 1966, certain federal share matching grants for historic preservation projects are available to certified local governments; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the CBJ Comprehensive Plan to identify and protect historic and archaeological resources; and

WHEREAS, the draft Juneau Historic Preservation Plan recommends that the City and Borough develop a computer database for easier access to the inventory of historic sites, structures, buildings, and objects; and

WHEREAS, the Juneau Historic Resources Advisory Committee has recommended approval of an application for a federal share matching grant for Phase II of the City and Borough of Juneau Historic Preservation Database; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has reviewed the application prepared by the Community Development Department to receive a federal share matching grant to conduct Phase II of the City and Borough of Juneau Historic Preservation Database; and

WHEREAS, The Assembly is fully cognizant of the obligations and responsibilities that will be incurred by the City and Borough upon acceptance of such grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. That the Assembly hereby authorizes the Manager to submit an application to the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, for a federal share matching grant for Phase II of the City and Borough of Juneau Historic Preservation Database.

Section 2. That the Community Development Department is established as the agent for the City and Borough of Juneau for administration of this project.

Section 3. That upon receipt of the grant to the City and Borough of Juneau to conduct Phase II of the City and Borough of Juneau Historic Preservation Database, the Assembly will introduce an ordinance providing matching funds for this project.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
