RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 2746

A Resolution De-Appropriating \$4,700,000 from the Salmon Creek Secondary Disinfection Capital Improvement Project, Loan Funding from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation.

WHEREAS, under Article IX of the Home Rule Charter of the City and Borough of Juneau, the Assembly by resolution may reduce any appropriation, except for debt service or for cash deficit, provided that no appropriation may be reduced by more than the amount of the unencumbered balance; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2011-11(E) and Ordinance 2014-24(AJ) appropriated \$1,270,000 and \$4,000,000 in loan funding from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation as funding for the Salmon Creek Secondary Disinfection; and

WHEREAS, this project is ongoing; and

WHEREAS, the entire awarded loan amount is not needed.




Section 1. The loan budget is de-appropriated from the Salmon Creek Secondary Disinfection Capital Improvement Project in the amount of \$4,700,000; all funding from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation.
