RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A Resolution De-Appropriating \$529 from the Auke Bay Interpretive Signs Capital Improvement Project, Grant Funding from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.

WHEREAS, under Article IX of the Home Rule Charter of the City and Borough of Juneau, the Assembly by resolution may reduce any appropriation, except for debt service or for cash deficit, provided that no appropriation may be reduced by more than the amount of the unencumbered balance; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2012-20(B) appropriated \$71,040 grant funding from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities as funding for the Auke Bay Interpretive Signs project; and

WHEREAS, this project and grant is now complete; and

WHEREAS, the remaining grant amount is not needed.




