A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 1545 TO PROVIDE FOR AN ALTERNATE ASSEMBLY REPRESENTATIVE TO THE JUNEAU ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, it would be in the public interest to provide for an alternate assembly representative to the JEDC board, in the event a regular member is unable to attend;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

- \* Section 1. <u>Amendment of Section</u>. Section 1(b) of Resolution Serial No. 1545 is amended to read:
  - (b) <u>Board Membership Criteria</u>. The mayor or the mayor's designee from the Assembly and one assemblymember of the city and borough shall serve on the JEDC board. One board member shall represent organized labor and one board member shall represent a nonprofit environmental organization. Candidates for the remaining five seats on the board shall be reviewed and selected based on their experience and expertise in fields relating to economic development, including but not limited to large and small businesses, entrepreneurship, natural resource development, tourism, banking and finance, higher education, engineering and construction, and government.
- \* Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
