RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

**A Resolution Supporting State Legislation Providing for an
Act to be Known as the "Managed Care Bill of Rights."**

WHEREAS, the Assembly is interested in both availability and accessibility of adequate health care by assuring health care is dispensed in a fair and equitable manner, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has reviewed pending state legislation which would regulate managed care-utilization review organizations to insure consumers receive an unbiased and fair review of their health care needs, and

WHEREAS, the Social Services Advisory Board at its meeting of November 2, 1995, and the Assembly Human Resources Committee at its meeting on March 21, 1996, recommended that the Assembly support regulation of managed care firms;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau supports Senate Bill 282 and related legislation establishing the "Managed Care Bill of Rights."
2. The Clerk shall distribute copies of this resolution to the Alaska Legislative Delegation.
3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
