RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1898

A Resolution Authorizing the Manager to Submit to the State of Alaska an Application for a Federal Grant to Develop a Historic Preservation Section on the City and Borough Website.

WHEREAS, it is a goal of the Assembly to increase access to Juneau as Alaska's Capital City via improved telecommunications and expanded public access to electronic information, and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the CBJ Comprehensive Plan to educate, encourage and assist the general public in recognizing the value of historic preservation, and

WHEREAS, it is an objective of the Juneau Library system to encourage all CBJ departments to contribute to the World Wide Web site maintained by the Library, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the National Park Service Historic Preservation Act of 1966, certain federal share matching grants for historic preservation projects are available to certified local governments, and

WHEREAS, the Juneau Historic Resources Advisory Committee has recommended that the city and borough apply for a federal share matching grant to develop a historic preservation section for the city and borough website, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has reviewed the grant application prepared by the Community Development Department, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly is fully aware of the obligations and responsibilities that will be incurred by the city and borough upon acceptance of the grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


Section 1. That the Assembly hereby authorizes the manager to submit an application to the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Office of History and Archaeology, for a federal share matching grant to develop a historic preservation section for the city and borough web site.

Section 2. That the Community Development Department is established as the agent for the city and borough for administration of this project.

Section 3. That if the city and borough is awarded the grant, the Assembly will introduce an ordinance providing matching funds for the project.


Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
