RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION URGING THE ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION TO CONDUCT HEARINGS IN JUNEAU ON THE REQUEST BY COOKE CABLEVISION FOR A TARIFF AMENDMENT TO INCREASE THE RATES AND CHANGE THE SERVICE IT PROVIDES TO ITS JUNEAU CUSTOMERS.

WHEREAS, Cooke Cablevision has filed with the Alaska Public Utilities Commission a request for a tariff amendment, denominated TA5-156, seeking to increase the rates and change the service it provides to Juneau cable subscribers, and

WHEREAS cable rates and service are a matter of significant public concern in the City and Borough of Juneau, and

WHEREAS, the Commission would be materially aided in its deliberations by testimony from the subscribers who will be affected by its decision, and


WHEREAS, for the vast majority of subscribers, such testimony is impractical if hearings are held outside of Juneau;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That The Alaska Public Utilities Commission is requested and urged to conduct hearings in Juneau on TA5-156, the request by Cooke Cablevision for a tariff amendment to increase the charges and change the services it provides to Juneau subscribers.

2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
