1. That Personnel Rule 7 07.0 is repealed and readopted to read:

- (1) the first of January, known as New Year's Day
- (2) the third Monday in February, known as Presidents Day
- (3) the last Monday of March, known as Seward's Day
- (4) the last Monday in May, known as Memorial Day
- (5) the fourth of July, known as Independence Day
- (6) the first Monday in September, known as Labor Day
- (7) the 18th of October, known as Alaska Day
- (8) the 11th of November, known as Veterans Day
- (9) the fourth Thursday in November, known as Thanksgiving

(10) the day after Thanksgiving

- (11) the 25th day of December, known as Christmas
- (12) every day designated by public proclamation by the President of the United States or the Governor of the State as a legal holiday.
