RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION
SERIAL NO. 674 TO PERMIT GREATER
FLEXIBILITY IN READING WATER
METERS DURING WINTER PERIODS.

WHEREAS, Resolution Serial No. 674 requires that water billings dated November through April be based on an estimated consumption, and

WHEREAS, with the installation of meters inside buildings readings may be made during freezing weather, and

WHEREAS, billings for water flowing through such meters should be based on actual consumption;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That Resolution Serial No. 674 as amended by Resolution Serial Nos. 688, 639 and 755 is further amended by changing Section 2L(1) to read:

(1) The city-borough will read water meters on a monthly basis insofar as weather conditions permit. Whenever a meter cannot be read monthly for reasons of weather or other unavoidable conditions, the monthly billing shall be based on estimated consumption with an adjustment made as soon as the meter is again read.

2. That this resolution shall take effect upon the day that Ordinance Serial No. 83-16 takes effect.
