RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER
TO LEASE PARKING SPACES TO THE PUBLIC.

WHEREAS, parking is a crucial problem affecting the vitality of downtown Juneau, and

WHEREAS, existing parking, a scarce resource, should be allocated to best meet the various parking needs between timed parking, all-day parking, and leased parking, and

WHEREAS, some downtown merchants and business persons require reserved parking to facilitate client visits and making deliveries, and

WHEREAS, several downtown merchants and business persons have lost reserved parking spaces recently due to construction on a private parking lot and re-allocation of spaces on other private lots, and

WHEREAS, the need for private leased parking for merchants and business persons far exceeds the existing supply, and

WHEREAS, the city-borough employee parking lot may be decreased in size;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the manager may immediately lease at market rates approximately 15 parking spaces in the public parking near the Alaska Steam Dock lot to downtown merchants and business persons who require reserved parking.

2. That the manager may lease such other city-borough owned parking spaces at market rates as he deems appropriate to best utilize public parking space to meet the various parking needs of the public.
