WHEREAS, said environmental assessment should be adopted as the policy of the City and Borough of Juneau for the West Mendenhall River Greenbelt:

- 1. The assembly adopts as its policy statement for the West Mendenhall River Greenbelt the Mendenhall River Greenbelt-Environmental Assessment dated October 27, 1983 with the following additions to be appended by staff:
- A. A discussion of the proposed transportation/ utility corridor crossing of the Mendenhall River and the greenbelt as identified in the draft comprehensive plan;
 - B. Estimated, realistic current land acquisition costs;
- 2. That the manager is authorized, within the constraints of available appropriations for the purpose, to immediately commence negotiations with property owners for purchase options and to acquire the necessary parcels as provided in CBJ 53.04.020 when funds for that purpose are appropriated.
