RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN AD HOC ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION AND ASSEMBLY ON A COMPREHENSIVE MINING ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, renewed interest in mining in the Juneau area raises the possibility that large scale mining operations may occur within the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the current ordinance regulating sand and gravel extraction and mining may not adequately address certain types of mining, and

WHEREAS, the municipality is retaining a consultant to draft a comprehensive mining ordinance, and

WHEREAS, it may be helpful to the assembly and to the Planning Commission to have the benefit of recommendations made by a committee composed of persons interested in mining and the regulation of mining activities:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

- There is established the City and Borough of Juneau Ad Hoc Mining Ordinance Advisory Committee consisting of seven members appointed by the assembly. The committee shall dissolve upon the adoption of a mining ordinance by the assembly unless the assembly, by motion or otherwise, establishes a different time for dissolution for the committee.
- The committee shall hold at least one public hearing after which it shall formulate and recommend to the assembly general mining ordinance policies that should be implemented in the mining ordinance. The committee shall review proposals made by the consultant and shall make recommendations on the ordinance to the Planning Commission and to the assembly.
