RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE ISSUANCE
OF A LIQUOR LICENSE AT EAGLECREST

WHEREAS, the Eaglecrest Ski Area is a municipally-owned and operated facility, and

WHEREAS, Eaglecrest is still a local, as opposed to a destination, ski area, and

WHEREAS, Eaglecrest caters to families and youth, and

WHEREAS, skiing requires a high degree of mental alertness and physical responsiveness, and

WHEREAS, Eaglecrest encourages the use of its skiing facilities by the youth of the community, and

WHEREAS, the consumption of alcohol decreases the mental alertness and physical responsiveness required for safe skiing, and

WHEREAS, consumption of alcohol decreases the mental alertness and physical responsiveness required for safely negotiating the streets and roads between Eaglecrest and the residential areas of the city and borough during the hazardous conditions that sometimes exist during the winter, and

WHEREAS, the support by the assembly of a license for the sale of alcoholic beverages at Eaglecrest indicates a support by the assembly of the sale of alcoholic beverages under conditions that are generally disapproved by the public, and

WHEREAS, the sale of alcoholic beverages at Eaglecrest would set a misleading and inappropriate model for the youth using the facility, and

WHEREAS, support for such a license at this time would be inconsistent with the overall policy of the City and Borough of Juneau relating to alcohol;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


That the assembly disapproves the issuance of a license to serve alcoholic beverages at Eaglecrest during the ski season.
