RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1084 (Substitute 2/4/85)

A RESOLUTION CREATING THE AD HOC
FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau is committed to balanced economic diversification in this community to assure a long term healthy economy, and

WHEREAS, one area of economic activity which has been identified by citizens that has potential that can be further developed is fisheries, including the production, harvesting, primary and secondary processing, and transporting of fish as well as the service and supply of the vessels, equipment, and businesses associated with personal use and commercial fisheries, and

WHEREAS, fisheries have long been vital to a large number of Juneau's commercial, recreational, and personal users, and are in a period of decline, and

WHEREAS, the assembly is seeking community input about what actions might be taken to develop, enhance and expand this important activity in order to create jobs, stimulate investments in our city and make Juneau a better place to live;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That there is created a nine person ad hoc Fisheries Development Committee to hold hearings, compile data and discuss with experts in the field the various options including expanded salmon production and other aquacultural development, infrastructure requirements of cold storage facilities, secondary processing, a fish loading dock, equipment and gear storage, a recreational fishing pier, and others.

2. That the committee shall be appointed by the assembly and shall report its preliminary findings to the

assembly no later than May 1, 1985 and shall cease to exist by December 15, 1985 unless the assembly by motion or otherwise extends the termination date.
