RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION EXPANDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE AD HOC ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION AND ASSEMBLY ON A COMPREHENSIVE MINING ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, by Resolution Serial No. 1076, the assembly established the City and Borough of Juneau Ad Hoc Mining Ordinance Advisory Committee consisting of seven members, and

WHEREAS, an expanded committee would provide the opportunity for a more diverse and balanced membership,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. Paragraph 1 of Resolution 1076 is amended to read:

1. There is established the City and Borough of Juneau Ad Hoc Mining Ordinance Advisory Committee consisting of nine members appointed by the assembly. The committee shall dissolve upon the adoption of a mining ordinance by the assembly unless the assembly, by motion or otherwise, establishes a different time for dissolution for the committee.

2. The two new vacancies created by this resolution shall be filled from those who submitted their name for consideration prior to the original appointment of the committee.
