RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 1136, THE RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR THE ASSEMBLY, AS AMENDED BY RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 1151, TO PROVIDE FOR A REDUCTION IN THE NUMBER OF REGULAR ASSEMBLY MEETINGS DURING THE MONTHS OF JUNE, JULY, AND AUGUST.

WHEREAS, the Assembly has determined that it can conduct the public business during the summer months with one regularly scheduled meeting per month;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That Rule 2A of the Assembly's Rules of Procedure as set out in Resolution Serial No. 1136, as amended by Resolution Serial No. 1151, is amended to read:

A. The Assembly shall regularly meet on the first and third Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m., except that during the months of June, July, and August it shall regularly meet only on the first Monday of the month, and it shall meet on the second and third Monday of September in order to avoid conflict with Labor Day, on the first and second Monday in January in order to avoid conflict with Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, on the first and second Monday of February in order to avoid conflict with President's Day, and on the second Monday in July in order to avoid conflict with the Fourth of July.


2. That all matters previously scheduled by the Assembly for action at its regularly scheduled meeting of June 16, 1986, are rescheduled for its regular meeting on the first Monday in July, 1986.
