RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION URGING THE ALASKA CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO INITIATE ACTION TO DETERMINE THE STATUS OF UNITED STATES SERVICEMEN AND SERVICEWOMEN MISSING IN ACTION OR OTHERWISE UNACCOUNTED FOR IN VIETNAM.

WHEREAS, more than 3,000,000 Americans served in Vietnam during the Vietnam War, and

WHEREAS, over and above the more than half million Americans killed or wounded in action in Vietnam during the Vietnam War, there are many Americans who served in Vietnam who still remain missing in action or otherwise unaccounted for, and

WHEREAS, reports continue to surface in the international media of sightings of Americans in Vietnam, and

WHEREAS, the government of Vietnam has apparently chosen to ignore established international law regarding the status of prisoners of war by refusing to divulge the names or the status of American service personnel imprisoned in Vietnam, and

WHEREAS, the Alfred John Bradford Post #4, American Legion, Juneau, and other civic groups and citizens of the City and Borough of Juneau have demonstrated continuing and growing concern at the manner in which the United States government is addressing this situation, and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Assembly that this tragic situation requires the immediate and thorough attention of the United States government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the Assembly urges Senator Stevens, Senator Murkowski, and Congressman Young to initiate action to determine the status of American service personnel missing in action or otherwise unaccounted for in Vietnam, and seek the release of all Americans being held prisoner in Vietnam.

2. Copies of this resolution shall be provided to Alaska's congressional delegation.

Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
