RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN REPROGRAMMED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS TO BE UTILIZED IN THE STABILIZATION OF THE HILLSIDE AFFECTED BY THE OCTOBER 15, 1986, MUDSLIDE.

WHEREAS, on October 15, 1986, a mudslide occurred near Third Street and Harris Street in the City and Borough of Juneau which resulted in damage to certain properties in the area of the mudslide, and

WHEREAS, the city and borough has developed a housing rehabilitation program using federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to provide financial assistance to eligible property owners in rehabilitating their homes, and

WHEREAS, it appears that certain improvements can be made to the hillside affected by the mudslide which will allow the residence on Lot 2, Block 105, Townsite of Juneau, to be reoccupied and help alleviate the potential for further damage to properties downslope from the mudslide area, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has adopted Ordinance Serial No. 86-31(AJ) which appropriates the sum of \$30,000 in reprogrammed CDBG funds to be utilized in the stabilization of the hillside affected by the mudslide, and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs, the agency which administers the CDBG funds appropriated for this project, has requested that the Assembly adopt a resolution indicating its approval of the use of the CDBG funds as set forth herein, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has determined that the project is exempt from federal environmental review procedures pursuant to 24 CFR Part 58.34(a)(8);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That pursuant to Ordinance 86-31(AJ), the sum of \$30,000 in reprogrammed CDBG funds will be utilized by the city and borough in the stabilization of the hillside near Third Street and Harris Street affected by the mudslide that occurred on October 15, 1986.

2. That such stabilization work is exempt from federal environmental review procedures pursuant to 24 CFR Part 58.34(a)(8).

Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
