A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 711 TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR THE NAMING OF PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS.

WHEREAS, municipal parks and recreation areas are an important resource for the citizens of the City and Borough of Juneau, and

WHEREAS, the names given to these facilities can be a matter of significant public interest, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly, by Resolution Serial No. 711, established the parks and recreation advisory committee, and

WHEREAS, the parks and recreation advisory committee has adopted a comprehensive and workable policy for the selection of names for municipal parks and recreation areas, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to establish a regular procedure for implementing committee name selections;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That paragraph 2 of Resolution Serial No. 711 is amended to read:

2. That a Parks and Recreation Committee consisting of nine members is established to act in an advisory capacity for planning and development of all phases of juvenile and adult recreation. The Committee shall also be responsible for the initial naming and any renaming of all municipal parks and recreation areas in accordance with standards adopted by the Committee. The name thus selected shall be forwarded for review by the Assembly.

Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
