RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1215

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE ORDER OF PRIORITY
FOR COMPLETION OF THE COMMUNITY-WIDE WATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, at a special election on June 7, 1983, the voters authorized an increase in the sales tax rate for a period of five years to partially fund the construction of a community-wide water system, and

WHEREAS, substantial portions of the water system project have been completed or are in progress at this time, and

WHEREAS, due to the decline in state funding and sales tax revenues allocated for this project, there are limited funds available for completion of the project, and

WHEREAS, given this funding limitation, the Assembly has determined that the remaining portions of the community-wide water system project should be prioritized;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That the following order of priority for completion of the construction of the community-wide water system is hereby established:

1. Area-wide Telemetry
2. Gold Creek Basin Improvements
3. Mendenhall Peninsula Water Distribution
4. North Douglas 3 Mile to Fish Creek
5. West Valley Phase I--North End
6. Wadliegh Creek to Indian Point
7. West Valley Industrial
8. West Valley Phase II

9. Indian Point Reservoir
10. North Douglas Reservoir
11. Crow Hill Reservoir
12. Lynn Ellen Heights to Crow Hill
13. West Juneau Water Distribution
14. Mendenhaven/Green Acres/Golden Nugget Corporation Stops and Curb Stops Construction
15. Mendenhall Valley Groundwater Study

Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
