A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 1225 TO EXTEND
THE TENURE OF THE JUNEAU BLUE RIBBON COMMISSION ON YOUTH.

WHEREAS, the Assembly by Resolution No. 1225 established
the Juneau Blue Ribbon Commission on Youth, and

WHEREAS, paragraph 6 of said resolution provides that,
after presentation of a report by the commission, the Assembly
may determine whether to establish a permanent advisory
committee on youth, and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 1987, the commission presented
its Interim Report on the Status of Juneau's Youth, and

WHEREAS, the commission has requested that the Assembly
extend its tenure until July 1, 1988, in order to permit the
commission time to complete its vital work, and

WHEREAS, an extension of the commission's tenure would be
in the best interests of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE
CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


1. Paragraphs 5 and 6 of Resolution Serial No. 1225 are
amended to read:

5. The commission shall report its
findings and recommendations to the Assembly
and the citizens of Juneau by July 1, 1988.
Upon the presentation of the report, the
commission shall dissolve.

6. After July 1, 1988, the Assembly
may determine whether to establish a
permanent advisory committee on youth.

2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
