RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER BY SALE TO THE KLEHINI VALLEY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT OF A SURPLUS 1970 MACK FIRE TRUCK.

WHEREAS, the coordinating fire chief has determined that the 1970 Mack fire truck presently held by the department is surplus to its needs, and

WHEREAS, after consulting with specialized fire apparatus dealers, the coordinating fire chief has determined that the truck has a fair-market value of \$20,000, and

WHEREAS, during the recent Alaska Fire Chiefs/Alaska State Firefighters Annual Conference, the truck was examined by representatives of various fire departments and equipment dealers, and

WHEREAS, the coordinating fire chief has received an offer from the Klehini Valley Volunteer Fire Department to purchase the fire truck for \$20,000, payable over a five-year period, and

WHEREAS, the Klehini Valley Volunteer Fire Department, established as Fire District No. 3 under the provisions of Chapter 07.30 of the Haines Borough Code, is a governmental unit providing fire protection service to approximately onethird of the Haines Borough area, and

WHEREAS, CBJ 53.50.220(c) provides that upon a determination by the manager that the best interests of the public would be served, the manager may transfer any surplus city and borough supplies to another governmental or quasi-governmental unit except that where the estimated value of the surplus of supplies to be transferred exceeds \$200.00, the transfer may be made only after approval by the Assembly by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. The Assembly approves the transfer by sale of one surplus 1970 Mack fire truck from the Juneau Fire Department, Service Area No. 2, to the Klehini Valley Volunteer Fire Department.

2. The sale price shall be no less than \$20,000, payable in installments, with an initial payment of \$8,000 and the balance, including interest on the unpaid balance at the rate of 8 percent per annum, payable annually over a five-year period.

3. The manager may complete the sale upon his determination that the best interests of the public would be served thereby, and to that same end may execute such documents upon such terms and conditions as may be necessary.

4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
