RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1279

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING
AN AD HOC COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SCHOOL FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau Charter, Article XIII, Section 13(b), and Alaska law, AS 14.14.060(c), provide that the Assembly shall determine and appropriate the amount of funds to be made available from local sources for school purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly desires to promote and further fiscal stability and predictability in local funding for school purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly believes that the present method of determining the amount of funds to be made available from local sources for school purposes could be improved, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly now desires to initiate efforts to develop a fair and equitable system for local funding of public schools which would assist and guide the Assembly in determining the amount of funds to be made available from local sources for school purposes, promote stability and predictability in local school funding, and help ensure that high quality education continues to be provided in the public schools of the city and borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. There is established the City and Borough of Juneau Ad Hoc Committee on Public School Funding.

2. The committee shall consist of nine members, including one member of the Assembly, and one member of the Board of Education. Nominations for the committee appointments shall be made by the Mayor, and shall be subject to ratification by the Assembly.

3. The task of the committee is to research, compile data, and make recommendations to the Assembly on a system for the local funding of public schools which would assist and guide the Assembly in determining the amount of funds to be made available from local sources for school purposes in a manner which is fair and equitable, enhances stability and

predictability in school funding from local sources, and furthers the goal of providing high quality education in the public schools of the city and borough.


4. The committee shall submit a report on its findings and recommendations to the Assembly and the citizens of Juneau on or before July 1, 1988, unless the Assembly by motion or otherwise grants an extension of time for submittal of the report. The committee shall be discharged upon presentation of the report to the Assembly.

5. The rules of procedure for Assembly advisory committees established by Resolution Serial No. 1180, as amended by Resolution Serial No. 1213, shall govern the conduct of business by the committee.

6. The manager shall provide the committee such staff support and assistance as may be available and appropriate.

7. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
