A RESOLUTION DECLARING A PORTION OF THE TEE HARBOR SUBDIVISION TO BE A SUBDIVISION IN WHICH A SUBSTANTIAL NETWORK OF TRANSMISSION FACILITIES HAS NOT BEEN INSTALLED.

WHEREAS, pursuant to CBJ 62.40.070, the Assembly must determine whether an existing subdivision or part thereof is one in which a substantial network of transmission facilities has not been installed; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has been advised as to the extent of installed transmission facilities in the Tee Harbor Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and Borough of Juneau that the Assembly make a declaration pursuant to CBJ 62.40.070 (b);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY & BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. The subdivision known as:

Tee Harbor, Alaska Subdivision, being a fractional part of Lot 2, U.S. Survey No. 3764, located within protracted Section 1, T405, R64E, and Section 36, T395, R64E, Copper River Meridian; more particularly described on the plat recorded on May 19, 1967 in the Juneau, Alaska Recording District, bearing Serial No. 67-830, excepting therefrom Lots 1 through 5 of Block 1 and Lots 1 through 17 of Block 2,

is hereby declared to be a subdivision in which a substantial network of transmission facilities has not been installed.
