A RESOLUTION CREATING
THE PROJECT PRIDE COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, our area is one of great natural beauty with an historic heritage in which all residents should take considerable pride; and

WHEREAS, litter, rubbish, garbage, abandoned vehicles and appliances, derelict vessels, debris along the coastline, gutted or abandoned or unkept structures, and like materials are offensive to the sight and are nuisances; and

WHEREAS, certain activities by their nature if not properly screened or situated are likewise offensive to the sight and are nuisances; and

WHEREAS, the efforts of those civic-minded citizens who maintain their premises and property in a manner reflecting their pride are negated to a large extent by the thoughtlessness of others; and

WHEREAS, the image of the community is lowered in the minds of visitors and pride in community of public-spirited citizens is lessened when nuisances which are offensive to sight are not corrected; and

WHEREAS, in spite of ordinances intended to preclude nuisances and efforts of public-spirited citizens and groups to maintain the community in a manner which is clean and free of litter, rubbish and other nuisances which detract from the natural beauty and historic heritage of the area, we have not been successful in maintaining the city and borough at a level of cleanliness satisfactory to the majority of its residents; and

WHEREAS, it must be recognized that a clean community cannot be effectively achieved through the diligent efforts of a few along with an annual clean-up campaign, but can only be achieved by the enthusiastic, coordinated support of all residents on a year-around basis:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


1. The Project Pride Committee is hereby created for the purpose of bringing the level of cleanliness of the city and borough up to a standard in which its residents can rightfully take pride and insuring that such level is maintained on a continuing basis by fostering civic pride on the part of all residents.

2. Duties of the Project Pride Committee shall be to:

- a. Solicit and encourage complete program support on a community-wide basis through the various business, civic, fraternal and other groups as well as through the public school system.
- b. Develop and implement an awareness program with the intent of fostering greater civic pride among residents of all ages.
- c. Organize community-wide clean-up campaigns to maximize participation and coordinate such activities.
- d. Develop and implement a program to provide appropriate recognition for those residents whose efforts are deemed worthy of note.
- e. Seek to enforce, in cooperation with the manager, in a firm but fair manner those portions of the code the intent of which is in line with the purposes of the committee.
- f. Recommend through the manager changes deemed appropriate to the existing litter and sanitation codes to achieve fairness, reasonableness and workability with respect to their intent.
- g. Recommend to the manager for consideration for inclusion in the budget means suitable to assist in clean-up efforts including but not limited to purchases of equipment.
- h. Perform such other duties and make such recommendations as are deemed appropriate to the successful accomplishment of the purposes of the committee.

3. The committee shall be composed of nine residents of the city and borough who shall serve without pay and who shall be nominated for appointment under policies expressed in Resolution 282. Members shall be appointed for an indefinite term. The committee may appoint such additional members to the committee as it deems necessary to achieve its purposes. The manager or his designee shall be an ex officio member of the committee.
