RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 2(e) OF
RESOLUTION #389, PROVIDING FOR RENTAL
OF OPEN MOORAGE AREAS IN THE
SMALL BOAT HARBORS

WHEREAS, Resolution #389 provides for 2 separate types of Open Moorage with individual fee schedules, and

WHEREAS, this procedure has caused confusion among boat owners and consequent problems of enforcement for the harbormaster; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and Borough and the persons using the small boat harbors that the fees and regulations be uniform and equitable.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Section 2(e) of Resolution #389 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1) General Public Open Moorage. Open moorage shall be permitted only for loading and unloading except on payment in advance of \$2.00 per day for boats of less than forty feet (40') in length and four dollars a day (\$4.00) for boats forty feet (40') in length and over, payable in advance.

(2) In areas designated by the Harbormaster as "free twenty-four hour moorage areas" such fees need not be paid. A boat may moor in a free moorage area for a period not in excess of twenty-four hours, and a break in moorage of at least seventy-two hours must occur before a boat is again eligible to moor in any such free moorage areas.


(3) General public Open Moorage spaces, as indicated below may be rented on a month-to-month basis during the period comencing October 1, and terminating April 30, of each year at a monthly rental of \$10/month for boats 20 feet in length and

under, \$20/month for boats 20-40 feet in length, and \$40 a month for boats over 40 feet in length.

Auke Bay - a maximum of 15 stalls
Harris Harbor - a maximum of 40 stalls
Douglas Harbor - a maximum of 10 stalls.
