RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 436
TO REDUCE FARES ON THE CAPITAL TRANSIT SYSTEM
AND TO PROVIDE CHANGE IN TOKENS ONLY.

WHEREAS, the assembly has determined that increased ridership will probably offset a reduction in Capital Transit fares, and

WHEREAS, a requirement that change for fares be given only in tokens will contribute to on-time bus runs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU:

Section 1. That section 1.B. of Resolution 436 is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. The single-zone fare shall be twenty-five cents (\$0.25) or one token for each zone or portion thereof.

Section 2. That section 1.C. of Resolution 436 is hereby amended to read as follows:

C. Tokens may be sold at the following rates:
(1) Forty (40) tokens for eight dollars (\$8.00).

Section 3. That paragraph 1.E. of Resolution 436 is hereby amended to read as follows:

E. The purchase price for a pass which may be issued to or used by a student is eight dollars (\$8.00) per month for a pass authorizing travel in one zone and an additional eight dollars (\$8.00) per month for each additional zone. Such passes may be purchased only through or by the school district or the University of Alaska-Juneau for issuance to and use by full-time students enrolled in an educational program of the sponsoring institution.

Section 4. That Resolution 436 is amended by adding a new section 1.G. reading as follows:

G. Exact fares shall be deposited by all riders not exempted under section 1.D or E of this

resolution. Change given by drivers shall be given only in tokens. One token shall be given for each full quarter-dollar of change due the rider. No cash change shall be given. Tokens may be redeemed for cash only at the discounted rates established in section 1.C of this resolution.


Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective on November 1, 1978.
