RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE REMOVAL  
OF PARKING METERS FROM THE PUBLIC STREETS IN  
THE JUNEAU SERVICE AREA (NO. 1)

WHEREAS, CBJ 42.14.010 authorizes the manager or his designee to establish parking meter spaces and zones with the approval of the assembly, and

WHEREAS, parking meters spaces and zones have been established within the Juneau Service Area (No. 1) with the prior approval of the assembly or its predecessor, and

WHEREAS, the assembly deems it in the best interests of the public to convert the present on-street, metered parking in the Juneau Service Area (No. 1) to unmetered parking;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the approval of the assembly under CBJ 72.14.010 to establish metered parking spaces and zones for on-street parking within the Juneau Service Area (No. 1) is hereby withdrawn and the manager is authorized and directed to remove existing parking meters and establish in their place a system of time limit parking restrictions commensurate with the time restrictions which were effected by the parking meters.

2. That, notwithstanding the authorization and direction in paragraph 1, the manager or his designee may establish such other time restrictions on parking in formerly metered areas as is appropriate in his judgment. Further, the assembly, by motion, may approve the establishment or reestablishment of a system of metered parking within any service area, an evaluation of the effectiveness and impact of this resolution shall be brought to the Assembly within 6 months.

3. That this resolution shall become effective on the day Ordinance 78-38 becomes effective and shall be implemented as expeditiously thereafter as possible.
