RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 654

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE JUNEAU TIME ZONE
ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, under the provisions of 15 USC §§260-267 (Uniform Time Act), the assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau, through Resolution Serial Number 569, petitioned the Secretary of the United States Department of Transportation to redefine the boundaries between the Yukon and Pacific Time Zones in such a manner as to include Juneau in the Yukon Time Zone, and

WHEREAS, after a review of potential advantages and disadvantages in regard to the convenience of commerce, the Department of Transportation changed the City and Borough of Juneau to the Yukon Time Zone, and

WHEREAS, a vote of the citizens of Juneau on March 28, 1980, indicates that a majority of the voters in Juneau oppose the move to the Yukon Time Zone, and

WHEREAS, new data and an evaluation of the effects of the time zone change are needed in order to request the Department of Transportation to reopen the issue, and

WHEREAS, the type of data collected and the method of collection may influence the evaluation of the time zone effects, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly wishes to obtain public participation in the formulation of a plan to assess the effects of the time zone change;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


1. That there is established the Juneau Time Zone Advisory Committee consisting of five members of the public appointed by the Assembly.

2. That the Committee shall determine the information which is needed in order to evaluate the impact of the time zone change; shall determine the method for the collection of that data; and shall devise a plan for its evaluation.

3. That the Committee shall submit a report by July 31, 1980, to the Assembly outlining a plan of data collection and evaluation regarding the time zone change.

4. That the Committee shall be dissolved two months after submission of the report unless assigned additional duties by the Assembly.
