RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER  
TO APPLY FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE  
FOR MELVIN PARK BALLFIELD LIGHTING.

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau has approved a comprehensive park and recreation plan which identifies ballfield lighting as a method of increasing the usage of municipal ballparks, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Land and Water Conservation Fund, federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of municipalities, and

WHEREAS, the assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau considers it in the best public interest to provide ballfield lighting at the municipally owned and operated Melvin Park, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau has already appropriated sufficient funds to meet the local share of said project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the manager is authorized and directed to make formal application to the State Liaison Officer for fund assistance on the subject project.

2. That fund assistance received from such application be used to meet the expenses of said project.

3. That property acquired or constructed with such financial aid through the State Liaison Officer be retained and used for outdoor recreation purposes by the municipality for the life of the equipment unless otherwise agreed to by the municipality, the State Liaison Officer, and the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service.

4. That this resolution shall become a part of the formal application to the Alaska Division of Parks.
