RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING A COMMITMENT BY THE CITY  
AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU TO USE MINORITY BUSINESS  
ENTERPRISES IN ALL ASPECTS OF MUNICIPAL  
CONTRACTING TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT FEASIBLE.

WHEREAS, it is city and borough policy to insure .  
that socially and economically disadvantaged persons have  
the opportunity for full participation in municipal programs,  
and

WHEREAS, the city and borough is committed to  
providing the fullest opportunity consistent with the law  
for minority business enterprises to participate equally in  
the provision of goods and services on a contractual basis,  
and


WHEREAS, toward this end, the city and borough  
should actively solicit bids from qualified minority  
business enterprises for the contracting and subcontracting  
of goods and services with the city and borough;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF  
THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. The city and borough shall, to the maximum  
extent feasible, institute a minority business enterprise  
purchasing program applicable to all aspects of city and  
borough activity. This program will allow the city and  
borough to work toward its goal of achieving social and  
economic justice for all segments of the Juneau community.
2. The manager or his designee shall set specific  
goals and timetables for increasing the participation of  
minority business enterprises in city and borough contracting.
3. For the purpose of this policy, "minority  
business enterprise" means a small business concern as  
defined pursuant to Section 3 of the federal Small Business  
Act and implementing regulations, and which is owned and  
controlled by one or more women, Blacks, Hispanics, Asian  
Americans, American Indians, or Alaskan Natives.
