RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO LEASE CERTAIN PROPERTIES IN THE VICINITY OF THE CITY SHOPS FOR THE PURPOSE OF STORAGE OF CITY AND BOROUGH EQUIPMENT, RECORDS, AND OTHER MATERIAL.

WHEREAS, certain facilities at which the city and borough stores records, equipment, and other material will soon not be available to the city and borough for such purposes, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide interim storage for such items until long-term storage can be arranged, and

WHEREAS, certain properties in the vicinity of the city shops are available and are adequate for such use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. The manager is authorized to enter into a one-year lease of Lots 14 and 15, Block 60, Tideland's Addition to the City of Juneau for a rental not exceeding \$17,000 per year.

2. The manager is further authorized to enter into a two-year lease of Lot 13, Block 60, Tideland's Addition to the City of Juneau for a rental not exceeding \$13,200 for the first year and not exceeding \$14,700 for the second year; provided, the lease may be cancelled if the Assembly fails to appropriate funds for an applicable fiscal year.

3. The manager may include in such leases other terms and conditions he believes are appropriate.
